

GETTING THE TEMPERATURE READING DURING HOT WEATHER PENNANT PLAY

To obtain temperature readings during Pennant play, you will need access to a device (computer/tablet/smart phone) running a Web browser.

Larger (computer or tablet) screen size preferred.


When following the procedures described in the Conditions of Play, the temperature should be checked as described below "immediately after" the hour and the half hour.

For most temperature stations, the relevant information will appear within 5 minutes of the hour and the half hour. It is important that the temperature that is noted is for the specified times, not other times (i.e. not 10 past, 20 past etc).

Critical to the efficiency of the procedure is to identify the person or persons who will be relied on to check the temperature. Whether it is a non-playing person (preferred) or a player involved in the game, they must be identified to the Umpire of the day and the Side managers and should be given support as needed to be able to be effective.





Click/tap on "Adelaide area latest observations" for the next screen




